What percentage of Cuba's electricity comes from imported fuel?

50% of Cuba's electric power comes from imported fuel. Fuel costs account for 70-80% of generation costs and Cuba spends more money on energy, about 14% of GDP, than most nations.¹⁰ A single state-owned utility, Unión Eléctrica, is responsible for managing and operating the electric grid.
