Maparangwane Air Base is the only full air base in Botswana. Sir Seretse Khama International Airport is a civilian airport that hosts the VIP jets and Francistown Airport is a joint civilian/military airfield with ...

There are 36 flights on 11 different routes from Gaborone Sir Seretse Khama International Airport, connecting GBE to 11 different cities in 7 different countries.

Sir Seretse Khama International Airport (FBSK) is located about 10 km north of the city of Gaborone, one hour flight from Johannesburg and two hours flight from Harare.
