

Does Phu Quoc have a power outage?

Phu Quoc relies on two undersea cables but they are not yet linked in a closed loop, meaning a single incident can knock out power across large parts of the island. The outage comes as Vietnam's most famous island destination enters its busy tourism season.

Why was Phu Quoc thrown into a blackout?

How many people in Phu Quoc remained without electricity?

Engineers rushed to reroute electricity from the Nam Phu Quoc 110/22kV substation, restoring power for about 17,400 customers, including hospitals, water plants, telecom services and several residential areas. But more than 12,000 households in northern Phu Quoc remained without electricity as of Sunday.

What happened at Nam Phu Quoc?

The impact tore through the 110kV cable supplying the island. Engineers rushed to reroute electricity from the Nam Phu Quoc 110/22kV substation, restoring power for about 17,400 customers, including hospitals, water plants, telecom services and several residential areas.
